

Everyone living in an Anglican Parish Has the right by Canon Law to be baptized in the Parish Church. The Law also provides that the Vicar can delay the baptism for the preparation of the family. It is the practice of this parish that everyone is offered a thanksgiving service as soon as possible and then after a 6 week preparation course baptism takes place during the morning service.

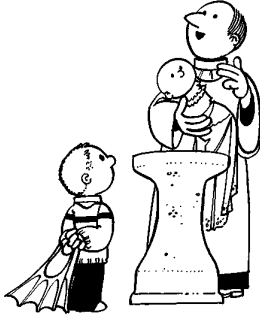
