# Who are we?

In February 2009 we appointed Mrs Tracy Barford as our worker and she was employed to work for 30 hours a week in developing the churches



work with its children and community based projects. Since then she has been working with the team that run

TOTS@OVERSTONE and with our Sunday Club teams. This has led to the launch of Kingdom Kids which runs every Sunday. She has also launched Blaze a lunch time club in two of our three local schools and we plan to launch in the third school soon. MOSH is the trust that supports this work.

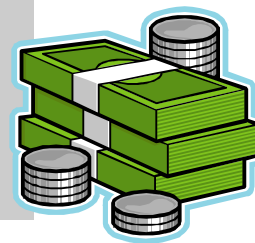
## Aims

We are also aware of the increasing pressure on our families and young people and it is key to the post that we offer pastoral care and support. We have been able to support local families at very difficult times and support them in dealing with challenging problems.



## Finance

At present we have sufficient funds to make an appointment on a one year contract based on 30 hours a week.



To fund the post for three years as a full

time appointment we would need to raise £20,000.00 per year.
